4. Having professional experience in the field of anatomy, manual therapy, manual medicine, special methods.
5. Developing or implementing innovative teaching methods.
6. Having a predisposition for teamwork.

Documents required from the candidate:

1. application for employment;
2. CV;
3. personal questionnaire for the candidate applying for employment;
4. copy of the diploma and other documents confirming the qualifications held and meeting the requirements set out in generally applicable regulations and containing data on prior employment;

7. declaration of having full legal capacity;
8. declaration on exercising full public rights;

3. Personal data is processed to recruit candidates for employment. Personal data is processed according to the following legal grounds: art. 22<sup>1</sup> §1 of the Act of June 26, 1974 (Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] of 2020, item 1320, as amended), art. 113 of the Act of July 20, 2018, Law on Higher Education and Science in connection with Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c) GDPR.
4. Candidates' personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations.
